

- pilot is single central node for catalog, no access to detailed records.
- full system node per region (country) and provides for refined catalog hitlist access to detailed source DB records (subject to security and any pricing) with translations
- UK design leaders

ERGO in UK



- set up prototype node at CLRC-RAL
- holding export copies of source DBs of 3 Research Councils (to avoid access to sensitive DBs)
- built the UK catalog node; uploading to Luxembourg (some already there) - each node has replicated catalog for all countries
- encouraging more organisations to join UK node (project with DTI/OST backing and support)
